



## ISSF WORLD CUP SHOTGUN LONATO DEL GARDA, ITA 7 - 17 MAY 2021







## TO ALL ISSF MEMBER FEDERATIONS

## Dear Friends:

In strict compliance with the health directives imposed by the Italian Government, CONI and the ISSF sport protocols, and with the aim of organizing a COVID FREE event with the maximum attention to the health of Athletes, Officials and all those who physically participate in the event, the LOC of the 4<sup>th</sup> round of the ISSF World Cup shotgun which will take place in Lonato from 7 to 17 May, thanks to the support and involvement of our fitters, has managed to obtain very advantageous conditions for setting up a village of tensile structures, and we would like to propose to the Federations that will be present at the Venue, the possibility of having a private gazebo for moments of relaxation of their athletes, in order to avoid crowding areas within the common structure which, even if equipped with dividing walls, would have common accesses and passage corridors.

One of the main purposes is to limit as much as possible common areas where mass gatherings could be created.

Access to the Venue will be monitored by thermo-scanners. Numerous sanity gel distributors (several of which are already installed) will be placed in many points of the shooting complex and, for those without, protective devices like masks, gloves, etc. will be available.

For this reason we would like to propose to the Federations the possibility of having a private tended structure with a surface area of 25 square meters (5 x 5) complete with flooring, table, benches and electrical connection, for the duration of the event, at the cost of EUR 1.500,00 taxes included.

In our opinion this would be the best solution to protect the health of all participants, even considering the recent presence of new variants of the virus not yet well diagnosed through rapid tests. Naturally, as required by ISSF Rules, for the Federations not interested in our proposal, the LOC will guarantee a common relaxation area.
